FIRE HYDRANT SERVICE ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued)

5. The repair and maintenance of the hydrants will be the responsibility of the applicant.
6. Any unauthorized use of water will be charged therefore under the General Metered Service schedule for the particular tariff area, and/or may be grounds for the Utility to discontinue the service without liability to the Utility.
7. There shall be no cross-connection between the fire hydrant service and any other source of supply without the specific approval of the Utility. This specific approval will require at the customer's expense, a special double check valve installation or other device acceptable to the Utility. Any unauthorized cross-connection may be grounds for immediate disconnection of the fire hydrant service without liability to the Utility.
8. The Utility will supply to the hydrant only such water at such pressure as may be available from time to time in the operation of the Utility's system. Section 774 of the Public Utilities Code limits the liability of the utility resulting from a claim regarding the provision or maintenance of an adequate water supply, water pressure, equipment or other fire protection facility or service. Acceptance of service under this tariff is acknowledgment of notice of the provisions of Section 774 of the Public Utilities Code.
9. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF. (D)
10. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission (C.P.U.C.), all bills are subject to a monthly surcharge of \$1.45 for each 6-inch standard fire hydrant. This surcharge will amortize the shortfall in revenue between the interim rates implemented on January 1, 2018 and pursuant to Decision 19-05-029 the rates approved in Advice Letter 335-W which became effective on July 6, 2019. 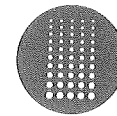

The purpose of this filing is to recover the difference between interim rates established by Advice Letter 325-W, effective January 1, 2018, and the final rates established by Advice Letter 335-W, effective July 6, 2019 in compliance with Decision 12-04-009.

**Background**

These tariffs are submitted as authorized by Decision 19-05-029 Ordering Paragraph No. 3.b:

*“2018/9 Interim Rate True Up Tier 1 Advice Letter by July 8, 2019”*

Suburban filed Advice Letter 325-W on December 20, 2017 to establish an Interim Rates Memorandum Account, and to implement interim rates the same as December 31, 2017 rates. Advice Letter 325-W was approved by Water Division on December 19, 2017 to be effective on January 1, 2018. Suburban filed Advice Letter 335-W on June 6, 2019 requesting final rates

pursuant to D.19-05-029. Advice Letter 335-W was approved by Water Division on July 2, 2019 to be effective on July 6, 2019. Suburban has determined the difference between the rates authorized by Advice Letter 335-W compared to the interim rates authorized by ALJ's Ruling on December 19, 2017 for the period January 1, 2018 through July 5, 2019. The total revenue shortfall is then calculated using recorded customer and consumption information for period January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. The total calculated revenue shortfall before interest related to the amortization period is \$7,912,849 or 9.51% of Suburban's authorized revenue for 2019.

Suburban is requesting to recover the approximately eighteen-month shortfall in revenue until the balance is fully amortized. Suburban will amortize the balance in the Interim Rates Memorandum Accounts through estimated 24-month and 36-month surcharges of \$0.204 and \$0.157 per 100 cubic feet applied to the quantity rates for San Jose Hills and Whittier/La Mirada Service Areas, respectively. An estimated 24-month surcharge of \$0.108 per 100 cubic feet applied to recycled water customers, and a monthly surcharge of \$1.45 for each 6-inch standard Fire Hydrant Service on Private Property. Also, an estimated 36-month surcharge of \$0.91 for each inch of diameter of service connection for Private Fire Protection Service.

#### **Tier Designation and Effective Date**

This is a Tier 1 filing – the advice letter is a compliance advice letter. Suburban requests processing by the Commission's Water Division so the surcharge will become effective on August 7, 2019.

In compliance with General Order 96-B, Industry Rule 4.3, a copy of this advice letter has been mailed or electronically transmitted to all interested and affected parties as detailed in Attachment A.

Detail work papers supporting the derivation of the surcharges have been provided to the CPUC – Water Division.

#### **Protest and Responses**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

- 5. The repair and maintenance of the hydrants will be the responsibility of the applicant.
- 6. Any unauthorized use of water will be charged therefore under the General Metered Service schedule for the particular tariff area, and/or may be grounds for the Utility to discontinue the service without liability to the Utility.
- 7. There shall be no cross-connection between the fire hydrant service and any other source of supply without the specific approval of the Utility. This specific approval will require at the customer's expense, a special double check valve installation or other device acceptable to the Utility. Acceptance of service under this tariff is acknowledgment of notice of the provisions of Section 774 of the Public Utilities Code.
