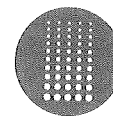

Pursuant to General Order 96-B - Water Industry Rule 7.3.1, Suburban Water Systems (Suburban) hereby seeks authorization to amortize the net under collection in the purchased water, pump tax, and purchased power reserve accounts for the period of July 2017 - June 2019 through a temporary surcharge of water used in San Jose Hills and Whittier/La Mirada Service Areas.

**San Jose Hills Service Area**

By this Advice Letter, Suburban seeks adjustment to its Tariff Rates for:

- Potable Water:  
Tariff Schedule No. SJ-1 - Residential Metered Service, and Tariff Schedule No. SJ-2 - Non Residential Metered Service, by assessing a surcharge of \$0.223 per 100 cubic feet of water used to recover a \$4,541,996 under collection including interest over a period approximately 24 months, commencing October 16, 2019.
- Recycled Water:  
Tariff Schedule No. SJ-3 - Recycled Water Metered Service, by assessing a surcharge of \$0.108 per 100 cubic feet of water used to recover a \$88,337 under collection including interest over a period approximately 24 months, commencing October 16, 2019.

- a. As of June 30, 2019, Suburban served about 41,964 potable water metered customers. In this filing, the recovery includes the following:
- An under collection amount of \$4,342,267 from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.
  - A 1.23% franchise fee amount of \$53,410 related to the under-collection request.
  - A 0.15% uncollectible amount of \$6,513 related to the under-collection.
  - An interest amount of \$23,368 for the months of July 2019 through September 2019.
  - An interest amount of \$96,490 for the months of October 2019 through September 2021.
  - An undercollection of \$19,949 for previously approved amortization amounts (AL 308-W).
- b. As of June 30, 2019, Suburban served about 42 of recycled water metered customers. In this filing, the recovery includes the following:
- An undercollection amount of \$84,835 from July 2017 through June 2019.
  - A 1.23% franchise fee amount of \$1,043 related to the under-collection request.
  - A 0.15% uncollectible amount of \$127 related to the under-collection.
  - An interest amount of \$454 for the months of July 2019 through September 2019.
  - An interest amount of \$1,877 for the months of October 2019 through September 2021.

**Whittier/La Mirada Service Area**

By this Advice Letter, Suburban seeks adjustment to its Tariff Schedule No. WLM-1 – Residential Metered Service, and Tariff Schedule No. WLM-2 – Non Residential Metered Service, by assessing a surcharge of \$0.214 per 100 cubic feet of water used in order to recover a \$3,405,984 under collection including interest over a period approximately 24 months, commencing October 16, 2019.

As of June 30, 2019, Suburban served about 33,200 metered customers in its Whittier/La Mirada Service Area. This recovery includes the following:

- An under collection amount of \$3,270,966 from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.
- A 1.23% franchise fee amount of \$40,233 related to the under-collection request.
- A 0.15% uncollectible amount of \$4,906 related to the under-collection.
- An interest amount of \$17,523 for the months of July 2019 through September 2019.
- An interest amount of \$72,356 for the months of October 2019 through September 2021.

The workpapers supporting the requested balances are supplied separately to the Water Division.

The present rates for San Jose Hills and Whittier/La Mirada Service Areas became effective on July 6, 2019 by Advice Letter No. 335-W that implemented a step increase.

**Tier Designation and Effective Date**

Pursuant to General Order 96-B – Water Industry Rule 7.3.1, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation, and Suburban requests this advice filing become effective for periods of approximately 24 months San Jose Hills and Whittier/La Mirada service areas or until the under-collection in the balancing accounts have been fully amortized, beginning October 16, 2019.

In compliance with Industry Rule 2 (3) and Rule 4.1 of General Order 96-B (Tier 1), a copy of this advice letter has been mailed to all interested and affected parties as detailed in Attachment A.

**Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.

If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact Suburban Water Systems at (626) 543-2500.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.
