Last November, you received a notice regarding the pending rate application of your water and/or wastewater provider. We are writing again to share that the Public Service Commission of South Carolina has issued its final order and approval of rates in Docket 2025-243-WS. **Effective April 1, your water and/or wastewater rates are changing.** For a full schedule of rates, please visit <https://swwc.com/sc/rates>.

Whose rates are changing?

All Kiawah Island Utility, Inc. customers will see a change in rates. Kiawah Island Utility, Inc. has been approved to continue doing business as:

- **South Carolina Water Utilities - CUC, Inc.** (serving Chechessee Bluff, Callawassie Island, Spring Island),
- **South Carolina Water Utilities, Inc.** (serving Pleasant Point Plantation and Harbor Island), and
- **Kiawah Island Utility, Inc.** (serving Kiawah Island)

What does this mean for your water and/or wastewater service in **Harbor Island**?

- **New base rates and consumption charges will be reflected on bills issued after April 1, 2026.** Rates may be pro-rated for a portion of your service period.
- **Wastewater service is moving to consumption-based billing.** Your wastewater bill has moved from a flat rate to a base rate plus usage charge per 1,000 gallons, based on your water usage.
- **Water Consumption charges will have new tiers of usage.** Residential and irrigation usage fees will change once certain levels of usage are reached. This helps to promote water conservation.
- **Other charges may have changed.** Please carefully review the full schedule of rates, terms, and conditions at <https://swwc.com/sc/rates>.
